Light of Christ – The custom of lighting candles is rooted in Church teaching that Christ is the Light of the World. Candles serve as an outward sign of one's faith and hope in God's help that is always sent to all who turn to Him and His Saints with faith and prayers.

You may have a candle lit as a way of entrusting your special intentions before the Lord. Your intention will be offered at every Divine Liturgy during the month for which your reserved lamp will burn.

To reserve a sanctuary lamp in memoriam or for special intentions, fill out the forms in the vestibule. (Reservations are on a first-come-first-serve basis.) Place your completed form in the collection basket or give it to an usher.



Teach whoever doesn't attend church that you chanted with the Seraphim, that you belong to the heavenly lifestyle, that you met with Christ and spoke with Him. If we live the Divine Liturgy thus, we will not have to say anything to those who were absent. But seeing our benefit, they will feel their own harm and quickly run to church to enjoy the same goods, with the grace and philanthropy or our Lord Jesus Christ, to Whom, together with the Father and the Holy Spirit, belong eternal glory. Amen.
