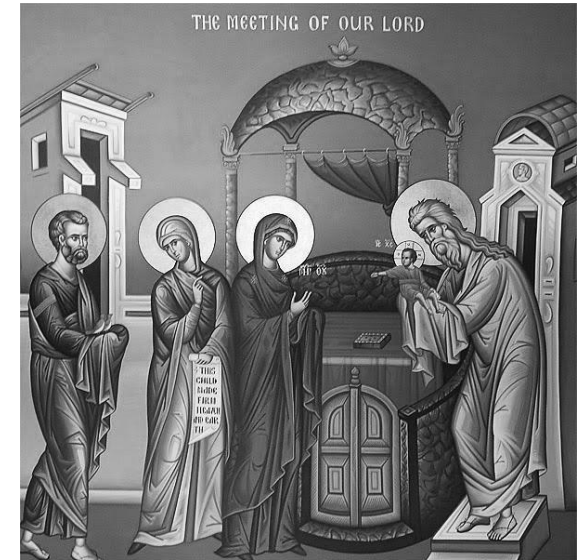


If you would like your home blessed, please contact Fr. Steven by phone or email and he will happily schedule it.
