How does God See You? – Have you ever thought of the question, how does God see me? The answer to this question can fuel not only how we pray, act, and be, but also how we even see the world. Depending on the answer, it can tell us whether we are hearing the right voice. Remember, the enemy comes and is deceitful and lies to us; he twists truths so that we may not hear the true Father's voice. We see that in the Garden of Eden in his conversation with Eve, and we experience it every day. How do we know which voice to follow? Well, we follow the voice that speaks truth.

The Truth says you are a good father or mother. You are a beloved daughter or son of mine. You are wanted and desired. The Father speaks to us through the Holy Spirit in words like that. He calls us by name. He calls us to Himself. He is gentle and loving.

The other's voice speaks to us in lies. The enemy says we are not good enough or we do not have what it takes. He tells us that we are unlovable and unforgiveable. His lies use our wounds and our sins against us. He accuses us of never being truly repentant. If we are struggling with the same sins over and over, he tells us that God does not really love us. He lies and says suffering means that God does not exist or that God does not care about us. He even lies to us to get us to focus on others' sins and forgetting that we are committing the same or maybe even worse.

Do you see the difference? Within your own life, what have you been listening to? Have you been focused on how others are living? The enemy uses a lot of tactics to get us to listen to Him. The one tactic he doesn't use is love. God loves and brings us out of ourselves and reminds us who we are and who we have been created to be. During this week, reflect on whose voice you've been listening to and believing. How have you been influenced or affected

in your belief about yourself? God sees us as whole, complete, and beloved sons and daughters. Do you see what God sees? Pray, reflect, and ask for healing in those places of yourself that are in need of restoration and resurrection.
