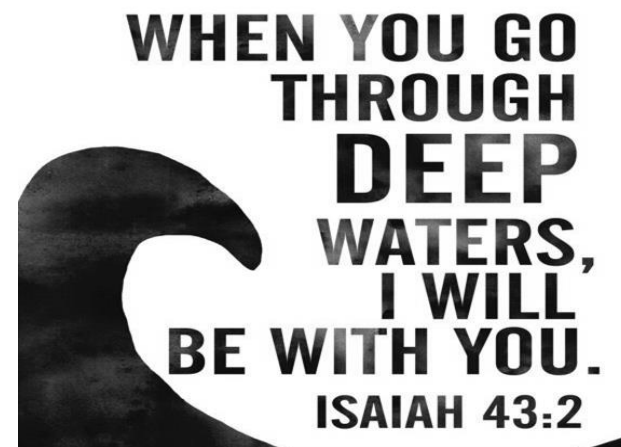

What Have You Learned About Yourself?

As we journey to the fourth week of the Great Fast, what have you learned about yourself? This is a good self-reflection question to really ponder, even if you feel as if you have not learned anything yet. Another question is what do you know about yourself? How do you deal with times of consolation, times of when you know the presence of God, everything is going according to the vision that was given to you? Just as important, is how do you deal with stress; when times do not look so bright, and God's presence seems so far away. Where do you turn? We need to know ourselves, not to be critical of ourselves, but to know where we need healing the most. How are those experiences in our lives influencing how we handle what is going on in the surface?

This week we are diving deep into our hearts, because, too often, we neglect our hearts. St. Ephrem the Syrian writes, "Our heart is the inner altar in which we offer our innermost prayers to God." Our heart is a place not even the enemy can go; however, we are easily influenced by the enemy to cut off our hearts and become hardhearted. May we use this prayer time this week to pay attention to your own heart, and to experience God in a deeper way.
