We Are the Living Breath of God – These past few weeks, we have been learning to go deeper within our hearts to be united with God in a more profound way. Our journey into the Great Fast has brought us a greater awareness of who we are deep within our heart. In the deepest places, we are being renewed, restored and reminded that we are a son or daughter of God. I encourage you this week to pay attention to what you sense, what is going on in your own heart. If there is joy, peace, gratitude sorrow, confusion, fear, disappointment, or any other emotion or sense, ask the Holy Spirit to reveal to you what you need to see or what memory is brought up into the light. These memories can lead you to a time of prayer to allow God to heal you through them.

This week our reflection will take us back to our very creation. In Genesis we read, "Then the Lord God formed the man out the dust of the ground and blew into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being." (Genesis 2:7, NAB) Just think about that for a moment and ponder the shear majesty. It is truly incredible that Lord God tenderly created us and so intimately united himself to us by breathing into our lungs and creating us in His image. God constructed us to receive His breath and to live off the air that He created to sustain our lives. Before moving on, reflect on this reality of the creation of you.

We hear in the Divine Liturgy of St. Basil the Great, "...we can do nothing good on earth." Seeing this statement for the first time, we may have to take a step back. Pay attention to what you are sensing as you first read it and maybe read it again. What was welling up inside? Paying attention to your heart is important for growing deeper into your relationship with God. The reality is that we can do nothing good without God. It is God who gives us life, direction and purpose. When we begin to move on our own, we begin to lose our life – meaning choosing

darkness, death and sin. We lose sight of what it means to be a Christian, and when we do not allow God to lead, we can cut ourselves off from the very one who gave us life.

This week reflect and learn how God is leading us. Our goal this week is to remember how we can do nothing without God. He is the vine and we are the branches. God is the very one who created us and breathed the breath of life into our lungs. May this week be a place of light, joy and peace as we dive deeper into the reality of God's love for us.
